
The exhibition invites the visitor to dive into a complexly playful and multi sensorial experience in the linguistic ambiguities of the word "rest" and perhaps encounter on the way questions relating to productivity and othering.

SoiL Thornton (b. 1990, US) lives and works in Brooklyn, New York. Their practice crosses boundaries of media, ranging from painting, sculpture, and photography to installation and video. SoiL Thornton grapples with identity politics, diversity, productivity, systems of order, and regulative apparatuses.
